We are struck at first and by chance, with what is peculiar and characteristic; also with permanent traits and general effects: this afterwards goes off in a set of unmeaning common place details. This sort of *pama facie* evidence, then, shows that a man is better than what he says or does; for it shows us the habit of his mind, which is the same under all circumstances and disguises. You will say, on the other hand, that there is no judging by appearances as a general rule. No one for instance, would take such a person for a clever man without knowing him. When then to one, he is not; he may have got the reputation but is a mistake.

Russel explains this with the help of the story of an imaginary baker and as butcher who are under the misconception that monopoly of trade world make them immensely rich. Every nation today seems to be pursuing an economic policy which is based on the misconception that her economic interest is opposed to that of every other nation. This is the assence of the pernicious idea of economic nationalism.

Since spontaneity is what is most thwarted by machines. The only thing that can be provided is opportunity. The use made of opportunity must be left to the initiative of the individual. No doubt understanding human nature must be the basis of any real improvement in human life.

But they do not dishearten him, for he has become familiar with the truth that the very essence of consciousness and of life is to be aware of limits and to strive to overcome them.

This must not be taken to mean, I think, that men are wholly indifferent to dress. It does not fill anything like the place in their mind that it fills in the mind of women, and there is an unwritten convention among them that it is bad form almost bordering on the improper to talk about cloths. It would smack of vanity in regard to one's personal appearance. Women can talk about clothes without this sense of personal vanity. They talk about it in a detached way as they might talk about pictures, or music, or any other aesthetic subject. They are interested in it objectively as an art. They like to see pretty dresses, even though they cannot hope to wear them. They throng to a wedding, not so much from interest in the principles as from a desire to see the cloths the bride wears. They like to see them much as they might like to hear a beautiful performance on the violin, although they themselves can hope to play the violin.

This is called "undermining" the sanctity of marriage.
